## Children

1. You mentioned that a very important rule for denial of childbirth is if the $1^{\text {st }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, and $7^{\text {th }}$ lords are with fewer points for the $5^{\text {th }}$ house, then there is very little chance for childbirth. Could any one of the $1^{\text {st }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, or $7^{\text {th }}$ lords being with less points bring denial, or do they all have to be with fewer points for denial?

All three planets should have fewer points, at least less than $\mathbf{1 2}$ points.
2. If the woman does not want children by choice, could she have good indications for having children, but in this case her personal choice overrides the good indications, or should she also have indications of denial?

If a woman does not want children by choice, I am of the opinion that a person can change his fate by his/her efforts. In this day and age, everyone is following family planning, and they do not want more than one or two children. This is a perfect example of how a person can change his/her fate by his/her own efforts.

Such a woman can have indications of denial of a child, and in this case, it will be the effect of the planets. In some cases, if Venus is more powerful, and Mars is debilitated for the $3^{\text {rd }}, 6^{\text {th }}$, and $10^{\text {th }}$ houses, the person does not want to take on the responsibility of caring for a child. The Moon should also be weak, or afflicted by Rahu/Ketu.
3. You mentioned a rule for denial of children for a woman. What about a man's chart?

For a male chart, we should consider the $5^{\text {th }}$ house, but for a female we should consider the $5^{\text {th }}$ house along with the $11^{\text {th }}$ house. The $10^{\text {th }}$ house also has importance. If the $1^{\text {st }}, 7^{\text {th }}$, and $5^{\text {th }}$ are with less points in the $10^{\text {th }}$ house, this also leads to denial of a child.

In general, when Gemini, Virgo, Capricorn, and Aquarius are in the $5^{\text {th }}$ house and aspected by Saturn with less points, while the $5^{\text {th }}$ lord is also with or aspected by Saturn, it also denies childbirth.

For a female chart, if the $4^{\text {th }}$ lord and the $8^{\text {th }}$ lord are with fewer points in the $5^{\text {th }}$ and $11^{\text {th }}$ house, it also reduces the chances for childbirth.

As per Vedic Astrology, if retrograde Jupiter is situated in the $5^{\text {th }}$ house, it will also deny childbirth. Other laws connected with Mars and Rahu are considered for abortion, scissoring, and miscarriage, particularly for a male child.
4. How do we look for adoption?

If any planet in the $5^{\text {th }}$ house is with more than 4 points, and if it is aspected by the $5^{\text {th }}$ lord with more points, the person adopts children. The marriage, when no child is there, generally happens in the sub of the planet having fewer points.
