

Longevity

1. How do we judge longevity?

Longevity is judged from the 3rd which equals House A when the focus house (House B) is the 8th, making House C the 12th house. If we take all these houses and calculate the points in row 17 of the work sheet, the significator having the maximum points can give the results for house B. This is a KAS law.

Now if Saturn in the 6th house (one of the dusthanas) aspects all these houses A, B & C, it is disqualified to give death unless there is a special case - such as Saturn having lordship of D or E. It therefore means it gives auspicious or benefic results.
